The James Capers Foundation established a BOOK SCHOLARSHIP for selected college students who are members of Covenant United church of Christ. The scholarship will provide \$500.00 towards the purchase of course books for each semester the selected students are in college, during the fall and spring semesters.

To be considered for the scholarship, the student must submit a one –page letter, single spaced essay stating their goals for college and how they plan on attaining these goals. Also, a one page typed letter from the student's parent or guardian stating how they plan to support their college bound student is required.

If you are chosen as a recipient for the scholarship, the following renewal guidelines must be adhered too; you must maintain a **2.3 G.P.A**. per semester, grades must be submitted to Rev. Ethel Southern on a semester basis. In addition you must show proof of a summer internship in your chosen field upon completing your sophomore and or junior year of college.
